Samantha Biddle started serving as Acting Transportation Secretary in August 2025. Previously she served as Deputy Transportation Secretary since 2023. Acting Secretary Biddle has spent nearly two decades in the transportation industry, serving in both the public and private sector.

As Deputy Secretary, she served as a member of the Secretary's cabinet and as the primary liaison to the Governor's office, leading on policy and operational matters to ensure the successful management of the Maryland Department of Transportation's (MDOT) Secretary's Office and six transportation modes spanning transit, highways, airport, port, tolling and motor vehicle services. Prior to joining SHA, Acting Secretary Biddle worked in the private sector as an Associate Transportation Planner with JMT Engineering for eight years.
